Steering Group Launch.

This took place in Victory Hall Sept 27th 6.30 – 8pm. This was attended by PC staff, Councillors and members of the public (20+) who had volunteered to be involved in the Broadclyst Neighbourhood Plan Steering Groups.

This was a **Taster Session**:

- Where Neighbourhood Plans were discussed in relation to their purpose and their context in the statutory planning framework. (Powerpoint presentation and Steering Group pamphlet)
- This was followed by a Taster Workshop where 4 Steering Group Interest Groups completed Tasks to give attendees a feel for the work involved by Steering Groups.
- No material covered was Confidential. Confidentiality issues will be covered in first official meetings.
- Workshop purpose was for members:
 - to decide if they wanted to commit to being a member of a Steering Group.
 - To spread the word to friends and family within the community as more members are required.
 - To produce specialist data and material which will be used in the next steering group meetings.
