

Tithebarn Link Road

What is happening?

A reminder that the Tithebarn Link Road comprises a new 600m highway with adjacent cycleways, footways and on street parking. This link road will connect the existing highway network north and south of the scheme, replacing Anning Drive which is a private road but is being used by the public under agreement between Devon County Council and Exeter Science Park.

Important Information

Although unrelated, works to drop the overhead power lines have recently commenced with Balfour Beatty, acting on behalf of Western Power, setting up their site compound just off Anning Drive and commencing excavation works for the underground installation to the north of our site.

We currently do not have an anticipated completion date for these works but we will up-date you in further issues of our newsletter.

Latest Update

Kerb installation has commenced, working from the north tie-in towards Blackhorse Lane. Elsewhere, the vast majority of drainage has been completed, with works now focussing on the road construction. E-On are progressing well with their district heating pipelines coming up through the site.

The works we will be progressing in the coming month will include the completion of kerb laying, fill to the verges to allow water mains, gas mains and power cables to be laid, and we hope to start surfacing on 25th September (first visit to lay the lower layers from Blackhorse Lane to the north tie-in).

The above works, especially the surfacing, will give us a hard surface to work off as the weather changes as we aim to complete in early 2018.
