

Anning Road, Exeter Science Park - Road Humps
Highways Act 1980 - Section 90A

Devon County Council propose to construct new ROAD HUMPS at 6 locations along Anning Road:

Location 1 – FLAT TOP ROAD HUMP (75mm high, 9m long and 6.5m wide) at a point 10 metres south of its junction with Tithebarn Way

Location 2 – FLAT TOP ROAD HUMP (75mm high, 9m long and 6.5m wide) at a point 64 metres south of its junction with Tithebarn Way

Location 3 – FLAT TOP ROAD HUMP (75mm high, 9.6m long and 6.5m wide) at a point 244 metres south of its junction with Tithebarn Way

Location 4 – FLAT TOP ROAD HUMP (75mm high, 9m long and 6.5m wide) at a point 330 metres south of its junction with Tithebarn Way

Location 5 – FLAT TOP ROAD HUMP (75mm high, 9m long and 6.5m wide) at a point 610 metres south of its junction with Tithebarn Way

Location 6 – FLAT TOP ROAD HUMP (75mm high, 9m long and 6.5m wide) at a point 708 metres south of its junction with Tithebarn Way
