When parking your vehicle please remember to:

- Park close to the kerb
- Leave enough space for a fire engine or an ambulance to pass
- Leave extra room near tight corners
- Fold in your wing mirror

Please be considerate when you park your vehicle. Failure to park your vehicle considerately may cause an unnecessary obstruction to other road users, including emergency services vehicles, which could lead to a £30 fixed penalty notice being issued.
