1. P3 FOOTPATH ANNUAL REVIEW

5. BABY BANK CHRISTMAS GIFT BAGS

We were lucky again this year to receive help from the Baby Bank with Christmas gift bags for the children of Broadclyst Foodbank clients. In total 21 bags were collected and given to families to help with the cost of Christmas. Many thanks to the Baby Bank.

Rediscover church approached us again this year with Christmas hampers to give to our foodbank clients. We collected food bags for 16 families which we delivered to each family.
