

1. TITHEBARN DEFIBRILLATOR

A hosting agreement is still sat with the Black Horse Pub, which was drafted to protect the ownership rights and operation expectations of the defibrillator. Once agreement has been approved, the installation of the defibrillator will commence. Discussions have been had directly with both the pub and the brewery, so it is hoped that we can get this in place in the near future.

2. SCHOOL TRAFFIC, ENVIRONMENT AND MOBILITY WORKING GROUP

The working group met on the evening of 26th May and reviewed any actions that were outstanding from previous meetings (copy of action tracker appended for reference). As part of this update, we received a report from Disability Together, the organisation who provided professional advice regarding how to overcome mobility issues within the parish (also appended).

Recommendation: The working group would like for the council to approach both EDDC, for the areas of Broadview and DCC for Highways' owned areas, to request support and funding for the recommended amendments to increase accessibility for the highlighted areas within Broadclyst Village. It is thought that the improvements required to DCC connected areas would benefit the continuation of the Clyst Valley Trail.
