

Broadclyst Fun Day 2026 Report

Broadclyst Fun Day took place on Saturday 27th June 2026 at Broadclyst Playing Fields. The event was organised as a community fun day, bringing together local organisations, businesses and residents for an enjoyable day of activities and entertainment.

Despite the exceptionally hot weather, the event was very well attended, with approximately 1,200 people visiting throughout the day. Nine local community groups participated alongside a total of around 50 stalls, including community organisations, local traders, food vendors and a licensed bar.

The day offered a wide range of activities and entertainment for all ages. Highlights included lunchtime performances from local children's Irish dancers, a classic motorbike display, and a self-defence demonstration. Children enjoyed races, an egg throw competition, face painting and a bouncy castle, while many stalls also provided their own activities and games. Visitors also had the opportunity to meet owls and alpacas, which proved very popular attractions.

Unfortunately, due to the heatwave and forecast high temperatures, the difficult decision was made to cancel the dog show on Friday 26th June in the interests of animal welfare. However, thanks to the support of Beaumont Vets, who kindly sponsored the dog show rosettes, plans are being made to hold a separate, larger dog show event at a later date.
