The engineers are working on this, and in liaison with the Neighbourhood Highways Officer.

We are getting into the pipeline to get DYLS at this location.

Link to Langaton Lane

Although the HATOC meeting is some way off on 17th November, I am hoping that the parish will reiterate or resend to DCC a view that this project is essential. If DCC agree to the construction of this walking and cycling link we:

- Don't have to return £100,000 to the developers
- Get Blair Homes to join up their internal shared use trail with this one. They have to build this, but only if we get the link built.
- Get a flat traffic-free route from Westclyst to Langaton and onwards for
 - children to go to
 - School
 - the scout hut
 - The MUGA and playing fields
 - Or for children to go in the opposite direction to
 - School
 - The skate park
 - The country park
 - The playing field
 - Commuters
 - leisure
- Don't have to send children up the hill and down again, and having to cycle on the carriageway in Orchard Close, which is a bus route.
- Finally deliver a project that we have been working towards at the WIG meetings for several years.

If the council do want to send a representative to the HATOC to speak in favour of this proposal, the meeting will be held at county hall at 10.30. I think you need to give notice beforehand that you intend to speak:
